Fuel Tax Replacement

- INDOT's Next Level Indiana 20 year budget includes:
- Immediate \$.10/gallon fuel tax increase
- Option for additional \$.01/gallon annual increase
- \$50 registration fee for hybrids
- \$150 registration fee for EVs
